## **MARCH CHILDRENS CLASSES**

There was a good turnout for the February Children's classes with eight students in each class. In each class we made poster board portfolios for the children to keep their artworks in.

The 5-8 age group practiced line drawing by making a composition purely with lines and then coloring them. For the 9-12 age group we did an exercise I chose for emphasis and subordination by drawing vases/faces and an upside down picture of a man sitting on a chair. The lessons were taken from Betty Edwards book "Drawing on The Right Side of the Brain". These exercises were challenging but magnificent for allowing the creative right hemisphere of the brain to take over by emphasizing spatial relationships and not allowing the logical left brain hemisphere to take over the creative process since it simply doesn't understand why the picture is upside down!

**SATURDAY, MARCH 9TH UPCOMING EVENTS:** For ages 5-8 we will be doing exercises with shape by making characters from geometric and organic shapes. For ages 9-12 we will be practicing unity and variety by creating a bubble monochrome. Unity will be accomplished through using shape and one color. Variety will be created with shape, size and adding black and white to create hues with one color of choice.
