FUND RAISING COMMITTEE

The Fundraising Committee is creating a calendar of members art to sell at the Sidewalk Show. The cost per calendar will be \$7 and sell for \$15. The first 14 members submitting a painting for the calendar will be accepted on a first come first served basis. There is a \$25 fee per participating artist. Please send your \$25 fee and a quality print or digital photo of your piece (5x7 or 8x10 preferred) to the ERAG PO box address by June 1st. The artist will be responsible for producing their piece in digital form for the printers. The \$25 fee will help us purchase 50 calendars to sell.

Ron will also be holding a framing class May 18th to help raise funds to purchase even more calendars. The fee for this class will be \$25.00. The more participants we get, the more calendars we can purchase. The calendars will retail for \$15, which will give the Guild an \$8.00 profit per calendar. It will also help expose your art. If we are successful, we can possibly sell them in bulk to businesses.
