CHILDREN"S CLASSES

We have been getting a lot of interest in our children's classes. They are continuing to grow. We are expecting full classes so sign your child up early to insure their spot.

For our April 13th classes we had fifteen children in our ages 5-8 class. We learned about positive and negative space. For the 9-12 age group we had nine kids participate. We learned about repetition and rhythm. We also created mandala's, sand mandala's and a class sand mandala.

On May 11th we had eight children in the 5-8 age group. We learned about light and color by painting color wheels and catchers. For the 9-12 age group we had four kids learning about values by practicing value scales. We also created forms from shape.

Upcoming on June 8th the 5-8 age group will learn about texture, weaving paper and something else that will be a surprise. In the 9-12 age group we will be learning balance. Both two and three dimensionally by creating mobiles.

Although our summer months will be filled with vacations and other numerous activities I hope to see all of our young artists using their creativity and imagination as usual. Thank you, Kamber.
