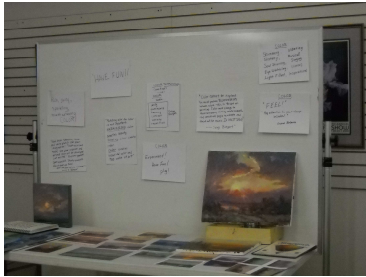
Board meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month at 4:00pm.
