
ART GUILD ON FACEBOOK

We are adding a new section to the newsletter where Guild members will be able to share ideas that they have come across or discovered on their own that may help others.

Helpful Ideas and Suggestions

- 1. Paint what you see not what you know. For example when you paint a tree you should paint the shapes you see and not the tree. If you paint what you know you will paint what you think a tree is and not what you are seeing.
- 2. Remember clouds have perspective also. Clouds closer to the horizon are smaller than those over head.
- 3. Usually in oil painting the darks are painted thinner than the lights.
- 4. When painting darks don't forget to adjust the temperature (either cool or warm) to match your painting.
